Details of Learning Solutions

CPCP1

Online proctored assessment – Learners are able to take their Part 1 and 2 papers from any location that suits the assessment environment long as learners are enrolled with the CILT Learning Centre.

In Person Assessment - Learners are able to take their Part 1 and 2 papers in paper format in the workplace following approval subject to appropriate invigilation arrangements as learners are enrolled with the CILT Learning Centre.

CPCP2

Work book produced by Eos Training is required by all students enrolled onto the qualification available in hard copy. This is updated each quarter to reflect any regulatory changes.

CPCP3

Coaching Support – 1-2-1 coaching with a Subject Matter Expert (SME) via digital platform or phone covering specific modules within the syllabus. Learners can purchase more hours of support if required. Prior to each session an agenda with desired outcomes will need to be completed by the learner and arranged with the CILT Learning Centre Team. This is also ideal for individuals who need to refresh on specific modules as part of their CPD. CPD certificates can be produced for a maximum of 2 hours regardless of the number of coaching sessions.

CPCP4

eLearning course with 12 month subscription to the learning platform The TMCPD syllabus is split into the following four modules for both Road Haulage and Passenger Transport:

- M1 Managing Business Operations
- M2 Managing Drivers
- M3 Managing Compliance and Risk
- M4 Transport Operations

Each module is broken down into elements for ease of learning as well as having knowledge check so learners can monitor their own progress to help to identify areas you may need to revisit to embed the learning.

CPCP5

Transport Manager CPC eLearning with digital classroom. The digital classroom sessions are an opportunity for learners to interact with other learners led by a facilitator on looking at the real life practical application of the learning from the online platform.

The facilitator will guide learners through scenarios linked to the learning outputs required by the syllabus and discuss the best options and decisions for each scenario. The digital classroom environment allows you to control how interactive you are. We encourage all learners to play an active part in the session, however we want everyone involved to feel comfortable.



Sessions include virtual breakout rooms and problem solving activities as well as 'in session' questions which appear on your screen and you are able to answer anonymously and act as a great knowledge test with the answer shared and discussed with the group.

Transport Manager CPC In Person Course – Organisations that want training delivered to a full cohort (approx. 10) at their location delivered as one block or two can contact the CILT Learning Centre to look at options and costings available dependant in needs.

CPCP7 THIS OPTION IS NOT CURRENTLY AVAILABLE

Transport Manager CPC Refresher In Person Course - Organisations that want refresher training delivered to a full cohort (approx. 10) at their location can contact the CILT Learning Centre to look at options and costings available dependant in needs.

CPCP8A

Operator Licence Awareness Course – includes 2 x 3 hr digital classrooms. Aimed at those who support the named 'O' license holder to help them be fully conversant with the requirements to maintain the operation's compliance, but who do not need to be qualified themselves.

CPCP8B

Transport Manager eRefresher Lite – includes 2 x 3 hr digital classrooms where the facilitator will guide learners through scenarios linked to the CPC standards and learning outputs required by the syllabus and discuss the best options and decisions for each scenario. Scenarios will cover key elements of the standard where changes are more likely to have occurred over the previous 5 years to ensure learners are up to date.

CPCP9

Transport Manager eRefresher Advanced - 4 x 3 hr digital classrooms where the facilitator will guide learners through scenarios linked to the CPC standards and learning outputs required by the syllabus discussing the best options and decisions for each scenario. Scenarios will cover key elements of the standard where changes are more likely to have occurred over the previous 5 years to ensure learners are up to date.

Learners will have access to eLearning platform to support refresher learning with core knowledge across the CPC standard. Learners will then be enrolled onto an online 45 minute assessment which will evidence an ongoing standard of knowledge which is certificated by the CILT Awarding Organisation.
